Monsoon Watch

The Depression over northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining Southwest Uttar Pradesh, near latitude 26.3°N and longitude 79.0°E, 20 km south of Etawah, 80 km east of Gwalior, 120 km east-southeast of Dholpur and 140 km southeast of Agra.
The monsoon trough at mean sea level now passes through Bikaner, Jaipur, center of Depression over northwest Madhya Pradesh & adjoining Southwest Uttar Pradesh, Satna, Daltonganj, Bankura, Digha and thence east southeastwards to northeast Bay of Bengal.
The upper air cyclonic circulation over North Interior Karnataka & neighbourhood at 3.1 km above mean sea level.

Significant Weather

Extremely Heavy rainfall observed over isolated place of East Madhya Pradesh,
Heavy to Very heavy rainfall observed at isolated place in West Madhya Pradesh. Moderate to Heavy over Chhattisgarh and Light to moderate rainfall over Vidarbha. Highest rainfall of 310 mm recorded at Chhatarpur in East MP.

Maximum Temperature

Maximum temperature appreciably fall in East Madhya Pradesh, appreciably rised in Chhattisgarh and no large change observed in West Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha. Maximum temperature were appreciably above normal over East Madhya Pradesh, above normal over Chhattisgarh and normal over West Madhya Pradesh and Vidarbha.

BRAHMPURI recorded the highest maximum temperature of 35.0 degree Celsius.

Forecast: No large change in maximum temperature for next 24 hours thereafter rise in temperature by 2 to 3 deg Celsius for next 2 days, then no large change in subsequent days, over most part of the region.

Minimum Temperature

Minimum temperatures were normal over entire region. No large change observed. NARSINGHPUR recorded the lowest minimum temperature 19.4 degree Celsius.

Forecast: No large change in Minimum temperature over the region.
