



## Regional Daily Weather Report

### Monsoon Watch

- ❖ The Western Disturbance as a cyclonic circulation over south Pakistan & neighbourhood now lies over north Pakistan & neighbourhood at 3.1 km above mean sea level with the trough aloft in middle and upper tropospheric westerlies with its axis at 5.8 km above mean sea level now runs roughly along Long. 68°E to the north of Lat. 28°N.
- ❖ The upper air cyclonic circulation over Comorin area between 0.9 km & 1.5 km above mean sea level persists.
- ❖ The induced cyclonic circulation over southwest Rajasthan & neighbourhood now lies over central Rajasthan & neighbourhood and extends upto 1.5 km above mean sea level.
- ❖ An upper air cyclonic circulation lies over northwest Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood at 1.5 km above mean sea level.

### Significant Weather

Dry weather prevailed over the entire region.  
Cold wave conditions experienced at 2 places (Raipur-Mana 8.8(-4.6) and Durg 9.4(-5.3) in Chhattisgarh.  
Shallow Fog (visibility 500m) reported at Gwalior.

### Maximum Temperature

No large change in Maximum temperature. They were above normal over most part of the region.  
The highest maximum temperature of 33.6°C was reported at AMRAVATI (Vidarbha)  
F/C: NO LARGE CHANGE IN MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE IN NEXT 07 DAYS OVER THE REGION.

### Minimum Temperature

Minimum temperatures appreciably rise over West Madhya Pradesh and No large change in minimum temperature over rest parts of the region.  
Minimum temperatures were appreciably below normal over Chhattisgarh and normal over East Madhya Pradesh & Vidarbha and above normal over West Madhya Pradesh. The lowest minimum temperature of 5.6°C was reported at AMBIKAPUR (Chhattisgarh)  
F/C: NO LARGE CHANGE IN MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FOR NEXT 4 DAYS, THEREAFTER RISE BY 2-3 DEG CEL IN NEXT SUBSEQUENT DAYS OVER THE REGION.
