Monsoon Watch

- ❖ An upper air cyclonic circulation lies over Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea level.
- ❖ A North-South trough from the above cyclonic circulation over Chhattisgarh to Gulf of Mannar across Telangana, Rayalaseema, interior Tamilnadu at 0.9 km above mean sea level.

Significant Weather

Light to moderate rainfall recorded at isolated places over Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh and dry weather prevailed over Vidarbha. HAIL reported at Bhind, Sheopurkalan in West Madhya Pradesh. Highest rainfall of 52.0 mm at ORCHHA-NIWARI in East Madhya Pradesh

Maximum Temperature

No large change in Maximum temperature in past 24 hours.

They were appreciably below normal over West Madhya Pradesh and below normal over rest part of the region.

The highest maximum temperature of 38.5°C was reported at RAJNANDGAON

FC: NO LARGE CHANGE IN MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FOR NEXT 24 HOURS THEREAFTER RISE BY 3-5 DEGREE CELCIUS IN SUBSEQUENT DAYS FOR MOST PART OF REGION.

Minimum Temperature

No large change in minimum temperature in past 24 hours. They were normal over most parts of the region.

The lowest minimum temperature of 17.0°C was reported at NOWGONG
