Monsoon Watch

- ❖ The upper air cyclonic circulation over East Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood at 0.9 km above mean sea level persists.
- ❖ The north-south trough from above the cyclonic circulation over East Uttar Pradesh to coastal Odisha across Jharkhand at 0.9 km above mean sea level persists.

Significant Weather

Light rainfall recorded at isolated places over West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha & Chhattisgarh and Dry weather prevailed over East Madhya Pradesh.
Heat Wave, Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning and Gusty winds recorded at isolated places in the region. Highest rainfall of 32.3mm recorded at Nagpur (Jagdarpur)
Heat wave observed at isolated pockets over Akola, Wardha in Vidarbha. Ratlam in West MP, Chhindwara, Mandla, Nowgong, Malajkhanda in East Madhya Pradesh.

Maximum Temperature

No large change in Maximum temperature in past 24 hours over most parts of the region.
They were appreciably above below normal over East Madhya Pradesh & Chhattisgarh and Above Normal over West Madhya Pradesh & Vidarbha.
The highest maximum temperature of 45.0°C was reported at AKOLA and WARDHA.
FC: NO LARGE CHANGE IN MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE FOR NEXT 3 DAYS, THEREAFTER RISE BY 2-3 DEG CEL IN SUBSEQUENT DAYS OVER THE REGION.

Minimum Temperature

No large change in minimum temperature in past 24 hours over most parts of the region.
Minimum temperature was appreciably above normal over Chhattisgarh and above normal over rest parts of the region.
The lowest minimum temperature of 21.6°C was reported at KHARGON.
FC: NO LARGE CHANGE IN MINIMUM TEMPERATURE FOR NEXT 48 HOURS, THEREAFTER FALL BY 2-3 DEG CEL IN SUBSEQUENT DAYS.
