



Weekly Weather Report of Vidarbha for Week ending on 26.03.2025

Chief Synoptic Features (20.03.2024 – 26.03.2025):

An upper air cyclonic circulation lies over southwest Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood and extended upto 1.5 km above mean sea level. A trough ran from the above cyclonic circulation over southwest Madhya Pradesh & neighbourhood to North Odisha across Chhattisgarh at 0.9 km above mean sea level. The trough from central parts of Odisha to south Vidarbha across south Chhattisgarh at 0.9 km above mean sea level became less marked On 20th .

The upper air cyclonic circulation over central parts of Madhya Pradesh extending upto 1.5 km above mean sea level persisted. The trough/wind discontinuity ran from south Chhattisgarh to South Interior Karnataka across Telangana and North Interior Karnataka at 1.5 km above mean sea level On 21st

The cyclonic circulation over central parts of Madhya Pradesh lay over central Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood and extended upto 1.5 km above mean sea level. A trough/wind discontinuity ran from southeast Uttar Pradesh to south Madhya Maharashtra across the above cyclonic circulation over central Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood, interior Maharashtra and extended upto 1.5 km above mean sea level on 22nd

The north-south trough from North interior Karnataka to south Tamil Nadu ran from west Vidarbha to south Tamil Nadu at 1.5 km above mean sea level. The cyclonic circulation over central Chhattisgarh & neighbourhood persisted and now seen at 0.9 km above mean sea level became less marked. The trough/wind discontinuity from southeast Uttar Pradesh to south Madhya Maharashtra across Chhattisgarh and Marathwada extended upto 1.5 km above mean sea level became less marked on 23rd .

The north-south trough/ wind discontinuity from west Vidarbha to north Kerala ran from south Chhattisgarh to north Kerala across Vidarbha, Madhya Maharashtra, North Interior Karnataka at 0.9 km above mean sea level On 24th .

The north-south trough/ wind discontinuity from west Vidarbha to north Kerala ran from south Chhattisgarh to north Kerala across Vidarbha, Madhya Maharashtra, North Interior Karnataka at 0.9 km above mean sea level on 25th.

The north-south trough from south Chhattisgarh to North Interior Tamil Nadu ran from south Chhattisgarh to Gulf of Mannar across interior Maharashtra, interior Karnataka, interior Tamil Nadu at 0.9 km above mean sea level On 26th .



