Weekly Weather Report of Vidarbha for Week ending on 19.11.2025

Chief Synoptic Features (13.11.2025 – 19.11.2025):

- ❖ The upper air cyclonic circulation over southwest and adjoining southeast Bay of Bengal extending upto 1.5 km above mean sea level persists. A Western Disturbance as an upper air cyclonic circulation lies over Kashmir and neighbourhood at 5.8 km above mean sea level on 13th November 2025.
- *The upper air cyclonic circulation over southwest Bay of Bengal off south Sri Lanka, now lies over south Sri Lanka & adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal extending upto 4.5 km above mean sea level tilting southwestward with height.
- ❖ The upper air cyclonic circulation over Comorin Area between 3.1 & 4.5 km above mean sea level has merged with the above cyclonic circulation over south Sri Lanka and adjoining southwest Bay of Bengal.❖ The upper air cyclonic circulation over south Bangladesh & neighbourhood at 1.5 km above mean sea level persisted on 14th November 2025 .
- ❖ The Low-Pressure area over Southwest Bay of Bengal off Sri Lanka coast persisted over the same region on 16th November 2025. The associated cyclonic upper air circulation extended upto 7.6 km above mean sea level tilting southwest with height.
- ❖A cyclonic circulation lay over Southwest Bay of Bengal & neighbourhood and extends upto 3.1 km above mean sea level. ❖ A low Pressure area is likely to form over Southeast Bay of Bengal around 22nd November 2025.
- ❖ Dry Weather continues to prevailed over Vidarbha from 13th to 19th November 2025.

Main Weather Observations

Cold wave to severe Cold wave conditions observed in isolated pockets over Vidarbha on 18th November 2025.


